MEMORANDUM FOR RANDOLPH FIELD EDUCATION FOUNDATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

SUBJECT: RFEF Meeting Minutes of March 9, 2026 @ 6:15 p.m. Universal City Library.

1. Pursuant to the authority contained in the RANDOLPH FIELD EDUCATION FOUNDATION Operating Policies, section IV.1.b dated 27 June 2016, the Randolph Field Education Foundation Board convened on 30 May 2016.
2. The following members were present: Jason Campbell, Carlos Perez, Charles Stubblefield, John Bender, Mike Miller, Barbara Miller, Brad Ward, Fatima Ward, Scott Denson, Brandi Clay, and Bill Fitzpatrick.
3. Treasurer Report given by Carlos Perez: Bank balance as of 3/9/26 stands at \$149,254.86. \$124,820 is Tim Porter Restricted Funds Money, \$24,434 is RFEF money with \$4,500 held back for Senior Scholarship Reserve Money. RFEF will issue a check for \$113,320 and \$1,500 to RFISD to be used for the baseball/softball batting cages and the completion of the mobile concession stand. Dr Holt has sent an email requesting this money to be released for the above activities. Tim Porter is hoping to donate another \$20,000 to RFEF in the next month. Dr. Holt has asked that that be split between RFISD and RFEF. RFEF has received donations from Susie Cannon (\$150), Cooper's Carwash (Silver Sponsor-Golf Tournament \$1,000), and \$50 from Deborah Steeves, class of 1971.
4. Discussed business:
 - A. Minutes from the February 23, 2026 meeting were reviewed and a motion by Brad Ward with a second from Charles Stubblefield was made to approve the minutes. **All approved the motion.**

B. Golf Tournament: Ross Wallace will check in with Quality Care Automotive and Golden Corral. We have a confirmation from International Hole in One that our contract is good to go for April 17, 2026. San Antonio Missions have game tickets they will donate as raffle prizes. Carlos Perez will check in with the company from California about sponsoring another hole for a free driver. Hole #10 will be sponsored by Canes, Hole #5, RHS Cadette Dancers, Hole #11 possible car, and Hole #7 \$10,000 Hole In One.

C. Air Show-May 2 & 3: Checking to see if we can receive help from high school students age 16 and up. Possibility of being cancelled due to world situation.

D. Senior Essays: Senior Essay Application Packets have been sent to RSS and 80 copies have been made. All essay's due on April 22.

5. New Business:

A. Ms. Kellogg and other Kindergarten teachers have sent a request for a teacher grant to Morgans Wonderland. The amount for the grant is \$936. Brad Ward made a motion with a second from Carlos Perez. **All approved of the motion.**

B. Ms. Haag, also is asking for a teacher grant in the amount \$200 to pay for 100 students to attend the SA Zoo. Brad Ward made a motion with a second from Fatima Ward to approve the grant. **All approved of the motion.**

D. John Bender will be donating another Sea Wold package as a raffle prize.
